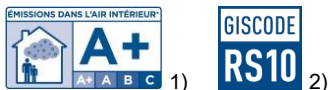

Subfloors

The subfloor as well as the room climate conditions must meet the requirements of the applicable standards and data sheets. The substrate to be bonded must be free of dust, grease and oil, and it must be stable and load-bearing. Sand in advance as needed.

Usage

WAKOL MS 246 StarMonti apply to the surface to be bonded in line form and join together within open time.

Important

WAKOL MS 246 StarMonti cannot be processed at temperatures below +5 °C or above +40 °C.

All information is based on approx. 20 °C and 50 % relative air humidity. In cold weather, warm up all laying materials in a heated room before use.

We guarantee the uniform high quality of our products. All data is based on tests and many years of practical experience and refers to standardised conditions.
